

Disabled Accommodation in Rye Bay area.

After going around each of the following accommodation providers, we would recommend them in the following order, in regard to ease of use and disabled facilities.

- **Woodlands B&B**, Whitbread Lane Beckley, Rye. (01797 260486). Very pleasant rural location on the A268 into Rye. Two rooms available, one with disabled access and facilities. Parking available just outside the door, with ramped access into room. Evening meals also catered for if required
- **The Place**, Camber, East Sussex. (01797 225057). Hotel on the edge of the sand dunes at Camber. Flat access, with rooms all on one level. 1 room with disabled access and facilities. Restaurant accessible with disabled toilet.
- **River Haven Hotel**, Rye. (01797 227982) Hotel on the outskirts of Rye town centre. 2 accessible downstairs rooms, with work ongoing to create veranda off the rooms. Restaurant accessible with disabled toilet.
- **Winchelsea Lodge Motel**, Winchelsea. (01797 226211) Motel situated in the countryside on the A259 to Hastings. Parking close to rooms with portable ramps to obtain access. No extra facilities, but the rooms are being revamped soon. Restaurant and bar partially accessible, but helpful and accommodating staff. (New function room with disabled access and toilet almost complete).
- **Rye Lodge Hotel**, Rye. (01797 223838) Hotel in the heart of Rye town centre. First floor rooms partially accessible to disabled. Restaurant accessible.
- **Rumples Inn**, Rye Foreign. (01797 230494) Situated in a rural location on the A268 into Rye, Rumples provides chalet style B&B accommodation (3 rooms with wheelchair access), with parking right outside. Restaurant is partially accessible.
- **Top O' The Hill**, Rye. (01797 223284) An Inn situated on the outskirts of Rye town centre. Chalet style B&B accommodation, with large rooms and ample parking just outside. Restaurant and bar partially accessible, but helpful and accommodating staff.
- **The Playden Oasts House**, Playden. (01797 223502) This small hotel is a converted oast house just outside Rye on the A268. Partially accessible for disabled accommodation. Restaurant and bar partially accessible.
- **Hare and Hounds**, Rye Foreign. (01797 230483) Situated on the A268 into Rye, the accommodation is in a separate converted barn, with 1 twin room having disabled facilities. Restaurant and bar partially accessible. Not visited.
