Saturday 3 <sup>rd</sup> April	<b>Sedlescombe Garden Society Spring Fayre</b> , Sedlescombe Village Hall Butterfly Conservation have a stall at the spring fayre. Please drop by and say hello.
Saturday 17 <sup>th</sup> April 10am to 3pm	<b>Identifying and Recording Butterflies</b> , Ivyland Farm, Netherfield (TN33 9QB). A free event including a morning workshop and afternoon butterfly walk for people interested in recording butterflies in the High Weald. This will provide all the preparation needed. Ideal for beginners or those wishing to brush up their ID skills. <b><u>Booking essential</u></b>
Saturday 1 <sup>st</sup> May 10:30am	<b>Woodland Skippers of Barnes Wood</b> . Barnes and Footlands Wood (TQ763202). A chance to see some of our rare woodland butterflies – Grizzled Skippers and Dingy Skippers, plus other wonderful spring butterflies and wild flowers. Meet in the Forestry Commission Car Park of Footlands Wood (between Cripps Corner and the A21).
Friday 14 <sup>th</sup> May From dusk.	<b>National Moth Night at Battle Great Wood</b> , (TQ765163) Marley Lane, just off the A21. Come and help to look for moths and bats in this excellent Forestry Commission woodland. Ideal for families. Good parking (off Marley Lane) and easy access. Bring a torch.
Saturday 22 <sup>nd</sup> May 10:30am	<b>Caterpillar Masterclass</b> . Brede High Wood (TQ803205). A search for the early stages of Butterfly and Moth life cycles, led by Dr Patrick Roper. Drawing on a lifetime of experience, Patrick will show us a few “tricks of the trade” and will demonstrate various techniques. With his extensive local knowledge Patrick will also be able to help us identify the food plants of many Butterfly and Moth species, a necessary prerequisite to finding their caterpillars!
